- 6) Applicants under the age of 25, with fewer than 30 transferable hours, must submit results of the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT I) and/or American College Test (ACT) sent directly to Centenary College from the testing service(s), or have scores listed on an official high school transcript (faxes and student copies are not considered official);
- 7) A letter of recommendation from a college professor.
