

PAYMENT PLANS

SEMESTER BILLING

Charges for the entire semester are paid at the beginning of each semester.

10-MONTH PAYMENT PLAN*

Charges for tuition, fees, room and board less scholarships, grants and loans are divided into ten equal payments. These are due on the 15th of each month, beginning in July 2008 and ending in April 2009. There is a one-time charge of \$50 for this plan payable with the first payment. This plan must be renewed in December 2008.

SEMESTER INSTALLMENT PLAN*

This plan allows you to pay one-half of the semester bill on or before August 20, 2008, and pay the remaining balance in three installments. Payments are due September 10, October 1, and November 1. Spring payments are due on or before January 7, 2009 and the remaining balance in three installments. Payments are due February 1, March 1, and April 1. There is a \$50 fee for this service each semester.

*As an early-bird incentive, the \$50 participation fee for either of these payment plans will be reduced to a \$10 participation fee if your enrollment form is received by July 15, 2008. For more information, call Monica Powell in the Business Office at 318.869.5016 or 318.869.5125.

LOANS

FEDERAL STAFFORD LOAN This low-interest loan from the federal government does not have to be repaid until six months after the student graduates or drops below half-time enrollment status. For loans borrowed after July 1, 2006, the interest rate is fixed at 6.8%. With the subsidized loan, the interest is paid by the Department of Education while the student is in school and during the six-month grace period. With the unsubsidized loan, the student is responsible for paying the interest on the loan while in school and during the six-month grace period. The student may choose to pay the interest as it accrues, or wait until graduation, at which time it will be added to the loan principal. Students are allowed to borrow up to \$3,500 for the first year of college.

PARENT LOAN Parents may finance up to the full cost of their dependent's education each academic year, minus grants and other financial aid the student receives. Although parents do not have to prove financial need, credit checks are mandatory. Repayment of these loans usually begins 60 days after disbursement.

Those students awarded a Stafford Loan will be sent a loan application packet. If you are interested in a Stafford Loan, and it was not part of your financial aid package, please contact the Office of Financial Aid. Information regarding the Parent Loan will be sent to all admitted applicants. If you have any questions regarding financial aid, please do not hesitate to contact our office.
