STUDENT APPLICATION

Nancy M. "Nan" Christian Scholarships are awarded annually to up to five (5) first-year students. Each scholarship equals the amount of tuition, fees, room and board. The scholarship is renewable for three years as long as a recipient maintains at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average. The Admissions Committee invites 40 applicants to compete for the award during Scholars Weekend, held on March 9 and 10, 2007.

During Scholars Weekend, the Selection Committee will interview candidates. While the academic credentials of applicants are important, the Selection Committee also considers character, maturity, creativity, community involvement, motivation, academic curiosity, communication ability and the potential to add to our college community.

APPLICANTS MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

- A letter of recommendation from a high school teacher
- An official transcript and standardized test scores from your high school
- A typed résumé outlining cocurricular activities, service and achievements
- A typed response to the essay topic (*see below*)
- All applicants must also file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

STUDENT: Ask a teacher to mail a letter of recommendation to Centenary College in the enclosed envelope. Give your application, essay and return envelope to your guidance counselor. Ask your counselor to mail an official transcript and standardized test scores along with your application and essay.
