I am not removing it from your degree plan unless you instruct me to do so; you may take it if you wish, but doing so will delay your graduation in May 2009 unless you drop a minor to reduce the number of hours you need. You must add a 3-hour course to your fall schedule, if you don't transfer HLTH 221 and you want to earn at least 154 hours and a Health minor. You have a No Credit in GED 251 and are not enrolled into GED 151 this fall. You must satisfy these two components. You can graduate with one degree and one major in either Psychology or Biology. no other issues**
