## Examples of Author Listings for the Student Research Forum

Recognizing the contributions to your research is important. In an attempt to standardize the presentation of authors and their affiliations for the student research forum brochure, I'm offering examples you might use in preparing your submission. I want to make sure we accurately represent contributions to the work, but I also want to keep the forum brochure as professional as possible by using standard formats.

The samples below give you an idea how project titles, contributors, and institutional affiliations would be presented in the forum brochure. If you aren't sure about the final formatting, that's ok. Just make sure you provide all relevant information to be included.

I've offered a brief comment to describe the distinction between each.

### Sample 1

#### Understanding the Difference Between Cell A and Cell B

Sally Student and Dr. Bob Smith  
Department of Biology  
Centenary College of Louisiana

Comment: Sally and Dr. Smith are both in the dept of biology at Centenary. Sally is assumed to have done her research work at Centenary. If she did the work elsewhere, she might mention it in the abstract.

### Sample 2

#### Understanding the Difference Between Cell A and Cell B

Sally Student<sup>a</sup>, Dr. Bob Smith<sup>a</sup>, and Dr. Kate Jones<sup>b</sup>

<sup>a</sup>Department of Biology  
<sup>b</sup>Department of Chemistry  
Centenary College of Louisiana

Comment: Looks like Dr. Jones from the Chemistry department was involved in the project as well.

### Sample 3

#### Understanding the Difference Between Cell A and Cell B

Sally Student<sup>a</sup>

Research Advisers:

Dr. Bob Smith<sup>a</sup>

Dr. Kate Jones<sup>b</sup>

<sup>a</sup>Department of Biology

<sup>b</sup>Department of Chemistry

Comment: I assume Sally did the project under the consultation of Drs. Smith and Jones, but it really wouldn't be deemed as a collaborative effort. For instance, this might be Sally's final project from her Senior Seminar course.

### Sample 4

#### Understanding the Difference Between Cell A and Cell B

Comment: This was a collaboration between multiple institutions. Mike is possibly a student at Centenary (and did the work along with Sally), but Sally will be the one presenting at the forum (as indicated by the “\*”). If Mike is presenting alongside Sally, I'd just leave the asterisk off.
