

Same Room/Same Roommate Criteria

This option allows current residents to select “*SQUAT*” their current room/suite with their current roommate(s) for the 2008-2009 academic year.

If I live in a four person suite in Rotary Hall and my roommates & I want to “*SQUAT*” our room/suite then we have to select our current room/suite with the same exact four individuals who currently live in this suite. If only three of the four roommates want to return to our suite then we will not be able to “*SQUAT*” our suite.

Residents will be able to “*SQUAT*” their suites in Rotary Hall and individual rooms in all other halls on campus.

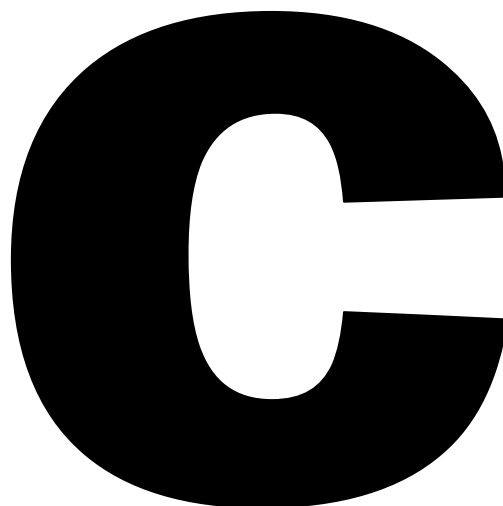
Below are the criteria for selecting the Same Room/Same Roommate option:

- All residents must be Room Lottery eligible. All residents must be current residents and have returned all Room Lottery material, Room Lottery Application Form, Roommate Matching Form, Campus Housing Agreement, and Meal Plan Form, by **4pm on March 31, 2008**.
- Residents taking advantage of this option must pick their current room/suite with their current roommate(s).
- All rooms/suites must be filled to the full occupancy as established by the Residence Life Office.
- If any of your roommates named on this form leave Centenary College for any reason, the remaining may be reassigned to another room or hall or have another person assigned to the room/suite to bring it to full occupancy.
- Although everyone gets a copy of this form, only one SAME ROOM/SAME ROOMMATE Form per room/suite is necessary. Each person named on this form does not have to fill out this form individually, but everyone will need to sign this form
- Falsifying any Room Lottery information may result in your loss of your room/suite selection.

If you are interested in taking advantage of the **SAME ROOM/SAME ROOMMATE, (SQUATING)**, option, you must fill out the accompanying form. Please remember that everyone named on this form must complete and return the Room Lottery Application Form, Roommate Matching Form, Campus Housing Agreement, and Meal Plan Form.
