Judges are interested in two aspects of your presentation: the research itself and your presentation of it. They will use the following 10 point rubric to determine first place winners.

Presentation: 4 points

- ___ Effective organization, including use of presentation aids as needed
- ___ Stayed within time allotted (12-15 minutes)
- ___ Effective verbal communication (tone, volume, pronunciation)
- ___ Effective nonverbal communication (eye contact, posture, hand gestures, etc)

Research Project: 4 points

- ___ Clearly articulated project goals
- ___ Scope of project was appropriately difficult
- ___ Provided supportive evidence/results
- ___ Project idea is significant/original

Q&A: 2 points

- ___ Responded effectively to questions

Fudge Factor: 1 point

- ___ Presenter went above and beyond...
