Student Scholarship Application

Ed E. & Gladys Hurley Foundation

HOW ESTABLISHED:

Mr. Ed E. Hurley, resident of Shreveport, Louisiana, established through his Will a trust with First National Bank of Shreveport, now JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. to be known as the Ed E. and Gladys Hurley Foundation. It was Mr. Hurley's intention that this Trust be established for the "purpose of assisting worthy and deserving young men and women to obtain college educations, when they desire such educations and they and their parents are financially unable to provide the funds necessary for the purpose."

Under this Will, scholarships are provided to applicants who are residents of Arkansas, Louisiana or Texas and desire to attend any College.

HOW TO APPLY AND DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED:

Each applicant must fill out the application form prepared for such purpose and submit it to the Trustee together with the following items:

1. A complete and official transcript from the high school and/or college attended prior to making application, including those from the current term (if enrolled) must be included
2. A personal statement of the applicant furnishing any special information that he/she thinks will be helpful to the Committee in considering the application
3. A copy of the most recent FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) Student Aid Report (SAR). **MUST INCLUDE SAI (Student Aid Index) or you will not be considered.**

WHEN TO APPLY:

Students must apply annually, as no scholarship awards are automatically renewed. These applications should be submitted to the Trustee postmarked **NO LATER THAN April 30th** preceding the school year in which funds will be needed. The Committee will notify the applicant whether or not such assistance will be granted. All applications should be emailed or mailed to the address on the front of the application.

NUMBER OF STUDENTS TO BE AIDED:

The number of students to be aided will be determined by the Trustee on the basis of the net income produced by the Trust and the number of acceptable applicants for assistance.

OBLIGATIONS OF WINNERS:

1. All of the recipients of any funds from this Trust are to maintain good standing at the college of his or her choice, as to character and conduct, and must maintain the academic average necessary for continuous attendance with good standing at the college attended.
2. All recipients agree to immediately notify the Trustee of any change of mailing address.
